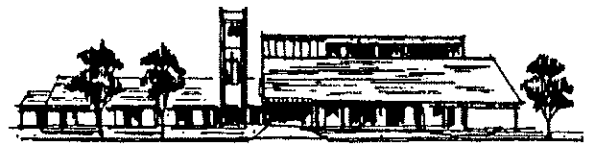

## SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

17 JANUARY 2010

### Today's Scripture Readings

*Isaiah 62:1-5; 1 Corinthians 12:4-11; John 2:1-11*

*The green of Ordinary Time is the green of growing things—of a growing church and Kingdom. In the gospel we hear of Jesus' first "sign": the water made wine, the feast continuing with joy. We step into the middle of Paul's instructions to the church at Corinth about different spiritual gifts working toward the same goal. Isaiah begins "For Zion's sake I will not be silent," and the Psalm echoes: "Proclaim his marvelous deeds to all the nations." The abundance of God's power and love is manifest and the season begins in a spirit of joy and confidence. This truly is the "Good News" that the Lord offers. We can go forward with joy and confidence and share the abundance with which God has blessed us.*

**ABOUT LITURGY:** As most of you are aware the Blessed Sacrament (tabernacle) has been placed in the Sanctuary. In placing the Blessed Sacrament in our worship space it is expected that the Presence be honored and respected. When entering into the worship area please genuflect upon entering the pew and upon leaving at the end of mass. It is also proper to limit conversations to the hall or foyer. The reason for reserving the sacrament is for adoration and to take to the sick.

On Tuesday evening, January 19<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 at St. Michael's Church in Sioux Falls, Bishop Paul Swain will initiate the Pastoral Planning Process for the Sioux Falls area. The initial meeting will include a prayer service and a presentation by Bishop Paul Swain on the Vision and Goals of the Pastoral Planning Process for the diocese and the Sioux Falls area. There will be a time for dialogue with Bishop Swain on the Planning Process. Each pastor has appointed a parish representative to participate in the planning process and to be the communication link with the parish. The parish representatives for our parish are **Randy Anderson** and **Mike Klumpp**.

**RCIA class resumes this Thursday, January 21st.** Please come and join us at 7 PM in Multi Purpose Room A. Anyone interested in learning about the Catholic religion is invited to come and participate in this class of Inquiry. Our topic this week is *The Church: The Body of Christ*. This is open to any Catholic who seeks to develop a better understanding of their own faith as well as those not of the Catholic faith.

## Sacraments

**Reconciliation:** Saturdays 4:00 – 4:45 PM or other time by appointment.

**Baptism:** A pre-Baptismal class is required for first-time parents. The class is held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM and parents must make reservations. Class is best done prior to your child's birth.

**Marriage:** Diocesan policy requires six (6) months preparation for all couples planning marriage. A wedding date can NOT be set until this preparation is underway. Prior marriage by either party usually requires an annulment taking an additional year. Contact Fr. Wagner well in advance of a desired wedding date.

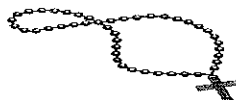

## What's Happening at Risen Savior Preschool

We wrapped up **G** and started **S-Snowmen & the Five Senses**. ♦**Circle Time:** Some letter S things children shared were: star fish, slippers, stuffed animals & snake. ♦**Faith Study: Stories of God's Love - 3-4s: God Made People.** God created people to share in His love. We are special. **4-5s: God always loves us.** God promises to always love and care for Noah, his family, and for all people. The rainbow in the sky is a sign of God's promise. ♦**Music & Movement: 3-4s: (To The Farmer in the Dell) I use my eyes to see, I use my eyes to see, and when I want to see a star, I use my eyes to see.** \*Repeating pattern: nose-smell-flower, ears-hear-bird, tongue-taste-peach, and hands-touch-cat. **4-5's: (To the tune of I'm a Little Teapot) I'm a little snowman short and fat. Here are my buttons, here is my hat. When the sun comes out, I can't play. I just slowly melt away.** ♦ **Art /Fine Motor/ Learning Activities: (3-4s)** We read "Spring Snowman," by Jill Barnes, and "Frozen Noses," by Jan Carr. Children were **surprised** to arrive to the Sensory Table filled with **SNOW** one morning, and had fun **scooping** and **stomping** in it-with toy animals. We worked together to make Rice Krispie treat Snowmen, using our 5 senses to find out how the ingredients changed as we measured, mixed and molded them. **(4-5s)** We made silly, sad & surprised faces. Check out the bulletin board down the hall towards the church to see our stamping & punch-out art snowmen & snowflakes on the letters S & s. Stories this week: "All You Need for a Snowman," by Alice Schertle, and "Snowbaby Could Not Sleep," by Kara LaReau. Snowmen art included using balloons to stamp-paint snowmen and making finger puppets to dance to the "Snowman Pokey!" We also played "Pin the Nose on the Snowman." Spreading cream cheese on mini-rice cakes, adding raisin buttons & eyes, pretzel arms & licorice scarves made **sweet & scrumptious** snowman snacks!
