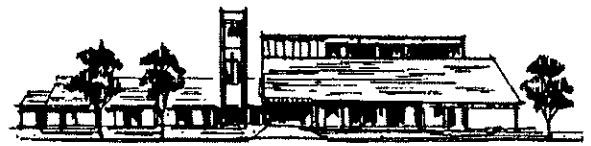

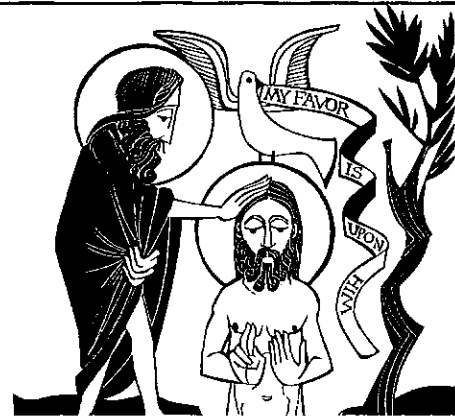

## FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

10 JANUARY 2010



Today's Scripture Readings

*Isaiah 40:1-5, 9-11; Titus 2:11-14, 3:4-7; Luke 3:15-16, 21-22*

What would you like to hear someone say to you when you apologize for a serious wrong? "Give me a little time to think about it." Or, "If you do thus and so, I'll forgive you." Wouldn't you prefer a response that is short and sweet to the ears like, "Forget about it, what's done is done." That is a way of saying the past has been clearly put behind us and we can start afresh. "Today is the first day of the rest of your life." God speaks this way to us through the prophet Isaiah. "Despite your transgressions and infidelities, let's put the past behind us. Let's make a new start."

**Remnants from Christmas:** Wasn't it impressive to have so many people come out in such blizzard conditions for the Christmas masses. Well over a thousand for all the Christmas masses. Over 650 folks participated at the 4 o'clock mass using every space available. It was wonderful to have the cameras, installed last spring, allowing the mass to be broadcast to the RE classrooms which served as part of the overflow area. Your previous pastor, Fr Kopel installed the network. The last two years that capability wasn't there. We have also been able to offer wedding couples a DVD of their marriage ceremony. Thanks to Wayne Miss and John Small who does the camera work. Would you like to be a part of the film crew? Contact Wayne Miss if interested in this ministry.

On Tuesday evening, January 19<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 at St. Michael's Church in Sioux Falls, Bishop Paul Swain will initiate the Pastoral Planning Process for the Sioux Falls area. ## Sacraments

**Reconciliation:** Saturdays 4:00 – 4:45 PM or other time by appointment.

**Baptism:** A pre-Baptismal class is required for first-time parents. The class is held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM and parents must make reservations. Class is best done prior to your child's birth.

**Marriage:** Diocesan policy requires six (6) months preparation for all couples planning marriage. A wedding date can NOT be set until this preparation is underway. Prior marriage by either party usually requires an annulment taking an additional year. Contact Fr. Wagner well in advance of a desired wedding date.

We honor Jesus in a special way during Christmas time. ♦**Music & Movement:** 4-5s Sang: *Twinkle, twinkle, little star, the Magi saw you from afar. Up above our Savior's bed, Where baby Jesus laid His head. Twinkle, twinkle, little star. The Magi saw you from afar.* ♦**Art /Fine Motor/ Learning Activities: All:** We read "Shopping With Dad," by Matt Harvey and Miriam Latimer. Children GIGGLED and grinned, as a little girl and her dad accidentally wreak havoc on a grocery store, irritating fellow customers & clerks. They end up teaching that, "Oops!" accidents happen sometimes & no one is to blame, but we can still do our best to make things right & help clean up the mess! Both age groups reviewed our Handwriting Without Tears "Mat Man" lesson, building Mat Man from the same wooden pieces that are used to form our letters, singing a song that helps teach all of the parts needed to draw a person. Children then drew pictures of themselves enjoying the world GOD made! 3-4s: Began a cutting skills project. 4-5s: I was Genuinely Grateful and Giddy about the GRAND letter G's the children Generated this week! We begin a new letter by tracing in the air, then use Q-tips dipped in water to write on chalk boards. During our workbook lesson, children have 1-1 time to practice on a dry erase board while others rotate through forming the letters from the wooden puzzle pieces & reviewing old letters.
